

KMS School Community Council Meeting
January 7, 2025

1. Welcome and Attendance - Mr. Bateman welcomed those in attendance. In attendance were Julie McQuivey, Natali Button, Desiree Felish, Colten Johnson, and Principal Bateman. Elizabeth Smith was absent. Mrs. Hooper attended the meeting as a visitor.
2. November Meeting Minutes: Reviewed and Approved. Julie motioned to approve. Desiree seconded. It was unanimous.
3. The question was opened up if there were any District/School Traffic Safety concerns. Natali mentioned about the students crossing at the end of the day over from the middle school to the high school. Mr. Bateman discussed how there is a plan in the near future to discuss moving end times for schools to allow staggered transitions. The council also discussed about the new traffic lights by Strawz that allows for better control at the intersection.
4. Mrs. Hooper discussed the Counseling and the College and Career program. She brought a folder with materials discussed at future PCCR's with the 8th grade students and their parents. Mrs. Hooper created an interactive counseling tab for students and parents on the school website. There was a QPR training given to the teachers during the January 6 teacher work day presented by Mrs. Hooper and Mr. Castagno. It seemed effective.
5. Mr. Bateman reviewed the Read180 data using NWEA growth scores. This is a new reading test. The whole school is showing reading improvement. The growth in the Read180 class is showing significant improvement.
6. The council was asked about future ideas for the upcoming school improvement plan. The council expressed they liked the Read180 class and it was a good use of funds.
7. Reviewed the upcoming KMS calendar until the next meeting
